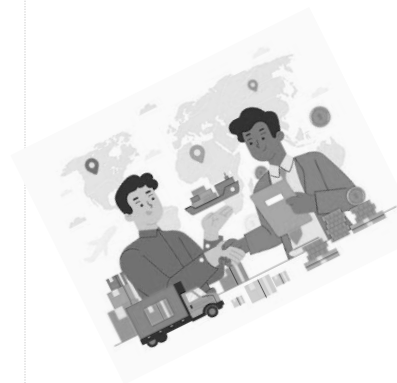

## Local Government

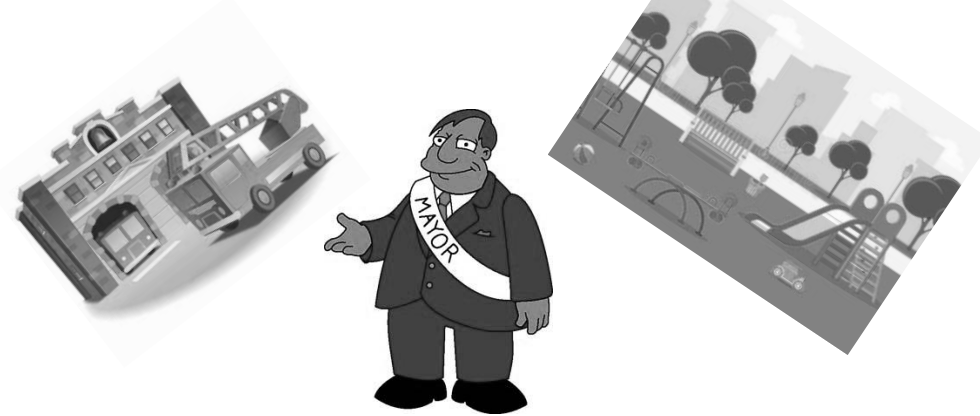
