Amendment XI

This amendment set limits on when a _____ can be sued. In particular it gave immunity to states from lawsuits from out-of-state citizens and foreigners not living within the state borders.



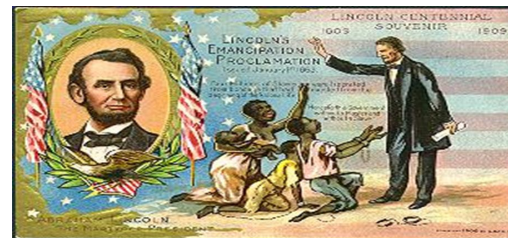
Amendment XII

- Outlaws the practice of _____ in the United States



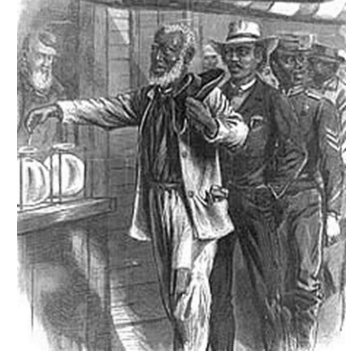
Amendment XIV

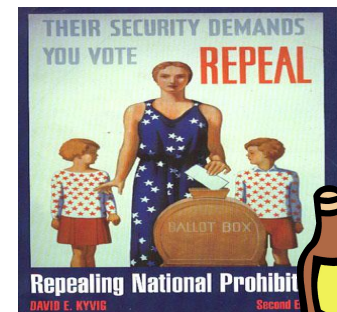
Amendment XX

- Poll taxes used to keep low-income minorities from voting



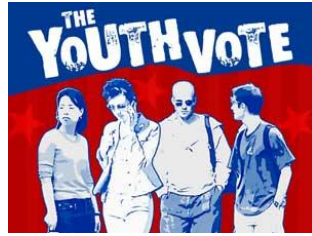
Amendment XXV
