Central \rightarrow plains with mountains in some places

• The Central Uplands are lower in altitude and less rugged than the Alpine region and are heavily wooded.

Significant Bodies of Water→ Danube River, River

- **Climate** \rightarrow humid continental to semi-arid climates
- The humid continental climate has
 summers and winters and supports mixed forests. Cold semi-arid climates have little precipitation and cold winters.

Charlemagne \rightarrow After the king's death, the region fell apart
