Directions: Cut out the equations. Match each equation to the correct expression.

Expressions in Word Form	Matching Equations
This number times 6 is the same as 30.	
Six times this number is equal to 30.	
If 21 items are partitioned into 3 equal groups, then this number of items is in each group.	
Some number of groups of 3 items is equal to 21.	
How many groups of two are in 12?	
Twelve is equal to some number times two.	
This number times five is the same as ten.	
Five is repeatedly subtracted from 10 this number of times.	
If 24 items are partitioned into 3 equal groups, then this number of items is in each group.	
Three times this number is equal to 24.	

$24 \div 3 = \diamond$	$3 \times \diamond = 24$	$10 \div 5 = \diamond$
$6 \times \diamond = 30$	$12 = \diamond \times 2$	$\diamond \times 3 = 21$
$12 \div 2 = \diamond$	$21 \div 3 = \diamond$	$\diamond \times 6 = 30$
$\diamond \times 5 = 10$
