
Literary Nonfiction

Literary nonfiction is when an author uses facts and research to create a story with no "made-up parts." These writings are dramatic true stories that can explore a variety of subjects. Literary nonfiction is also called narrative nonfiction and creative nonfiction. It includes travel writing, essays, autobiography, memoir, biography, sports writing, science writing, and nature writing.
