Close readers compare and contrast the treatment of similar themes and topics and patterns of events in stories, myths, and traditional literature from different cultures.

WHAT DO I KNOW ABOUT MYTHS?

- -- Answer serious questions about how important things began and occurred.
- -- Stories that explain natural occurrences and express beliefs of right and wrong.
 - -- To explain the creation of the world.
- -- To teach people moral lessons.
- -- The gods/goddesses and heroes are superhuman in nature, and sometimes appear in disguised form.
- -- Human emotions are experienced by the gods.
- -- Magic is often present in myths.
 - -- A metamorphosis may occur (transformation/change)

WHAT DO I KNOW ABOUT LEGENDS?

- -- Stories are usually about a person or place
- -- Person may be real or based on a real person
 - -- Rooted in oral tradition but embellished through the generation
 - -- Told as if it were a historical event
- -- Evidence of the existence of actual figure in an actual point of time in the past
- -- Legends are subsets of folktales
