



SQUARE NUMBERS



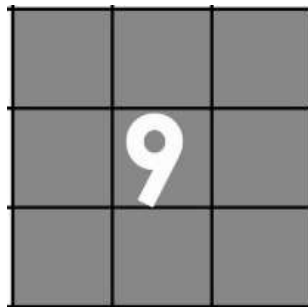
When we multiply a whole number by itself, the result is a square number.

EXAMPLES



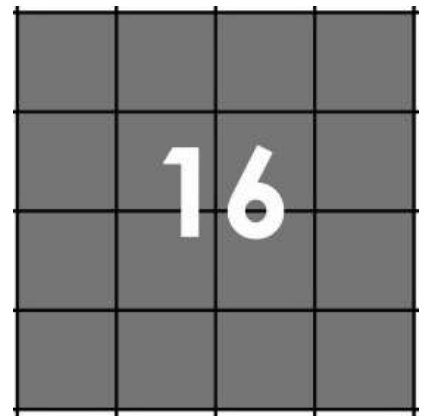
$$2 \times 2 = 4$$

4 is a square number



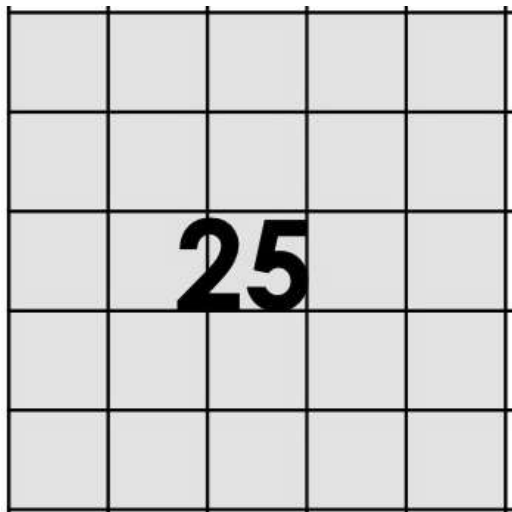
$$3 \times 3 = 9$$

9 is a square number



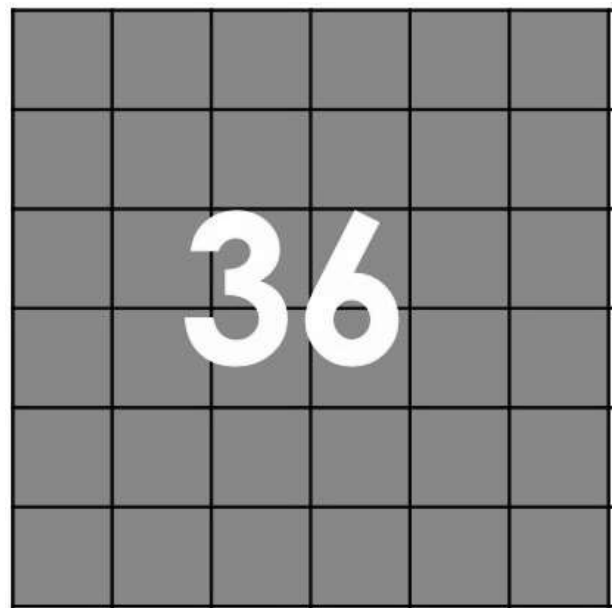
$$4 \times 4 = 16$$

16 is a square number



$$5 \times 5 = 25$$

25 is a square number



$$6 \times 6 = 36$$

36 is a square number
