## Importance of Personality:

- **Personality** → the combination of characteristics or qualities that form an individual's distinctive \_\_\_\_\_
- **Personality Psychology** → the study of how personality \_\_\_\_\_
  - One of the largest and most popular branches of psychology
  - Researchers in the area also strive to understand how personality influences out \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_
- **Unique**
  - Personalities make each person \_\_\_\_\_ and who they are
  - Influences \_\_\_\_\_ (relationships, way you live, jobs, etc)
- **Situations**
  - Understanding personalities helps predict how people will \_\_\_\_\_ to certain situations and what they might \_\_\_\_\_
- **Careers**
  - Many careers need to have a psychological understanding of personalities:
    - \_\_\_\_\_ → studies and interprets how individuals relate to others and their environments
    - \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_ → help manage addiction and behavior/mental health conditions
    - \_\_\_\_\_ Manager → develops programs to enhance employee skills and knowledge
    - \_\_\_\_\_ (or related field) → study personalities to predict reasoning and next moves of criminals
  - The need to understand people's personalities is growing
    - **#1** → \_\_\_\_\_ to understand why some soldiers get PTSD and others do not
    - **#2** → \_\_\_\_\_ designers for self-improvement and motivation apps
    - **#3** → \_\_\_\_\_ for businesses to help with hiring, employee retainment, and marketing
- **Personality Disorders:**
  - Understanding personality psychology helps to understand personality disorders
    - \_\_\_\_\_ personality disorder → person consistently shows no regard for right and wrong, and ignores the rights and feelings of others
    - \_\_\_\_\_ personality disorder → person has long-term patterns of unstable or explosive emotions

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- \_\_\_\_\_ personality disorder → person has an excessive need to be taken care of and can often manifest as “clinging” behavior or a fear of separation
- \_\_\_\_\_ personality disorder → person has patterns of self-centered, arrogant thinking and behavior, and an excessive need for admiration
- \_\_\_\_\_ personality disorder → person has an obsession with order, perfectionism, control, and specific ways of doing things
- \_\_\_\_\_ personality disorder → person has consistent pattern of detachment from, and general disinterest in, social relationships

## Personality Theories:

- Some of the best-known theories in psychology are devoted to understanding and explaining how personality develops
  - \_\_\_\_\_ **Theory**
    - Sigmund \_\_\_\_\_ suggested that personality develops through a series of five psychosexual stages
      - At each stage, the energy of the \_\_\_\_\_ (primal, instinctual part of personality) is focused on a specific area of the \_\_\_\_\_
      - Freud believed that early childhood \_\_\_\_\_ play an important role in formation of personality
        - Personality was mostly established by age of \_\_\_\_\_

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- \_\_\_\_\_ Theory
  - Perspective that stresses the positive side of \_\_\_\_\_
    - Maslow's hierarchy of needs suggests that humans are \_\_\_\_\_ to reach a state of self-actualization marked by a coherent, cohesive personality
    - Carl Rogers believed that when a person's perceived self and ideal self are \_\_\_\_\_, it's a sign of a healthy personality
- \_\_\_\_\_ Theory
  - Suggests that personality comprises \_\_\_\_\_ different traits or broad dispositions
    - There are many trait theories, but the \_\_\_\_\_ theory is most accepted
      - Suggests that personality is made up of five broad dimensions
