



Las Guayabas ~ Guavas

She is the motherly saint of love, compassion and hope for suffering and oppressed people.






Nopales is Spanish for the prickly pear cactus. It can be eaten pickled or cooked.




Pepinos are sliced cucumbers sprinkled with salt and ground *chiles*.
