

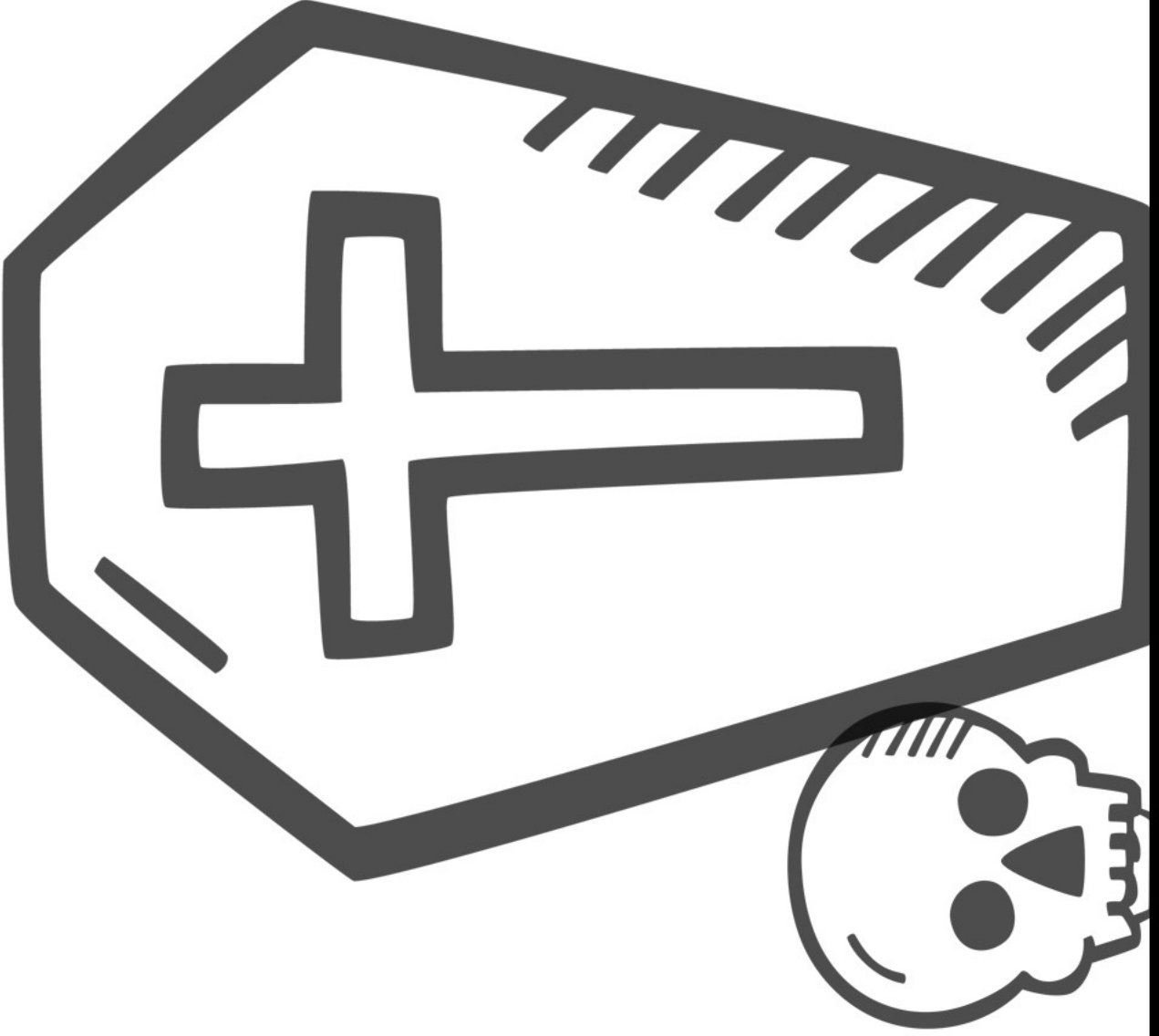

# THE TELL TALE HEART

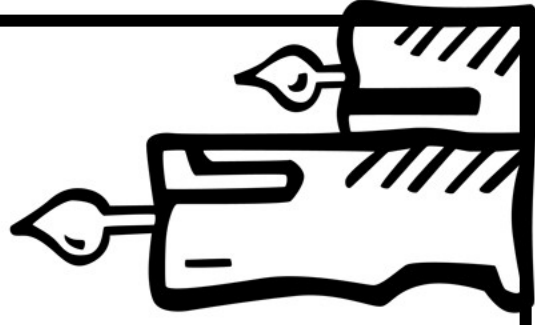
Do you relate to any of the characters in the story? If so, which ones and how? If not, how are you different?
