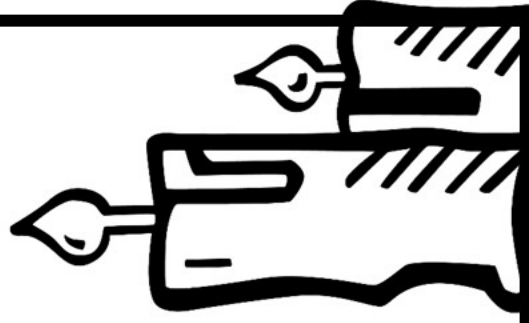
In stanza three, what fills the narrator's heart with terror?
