FUN FACT

Not all countries use a dot to represent the decimal point! Some countries use a comma. We write *two hundred fourteen and thirty-six hundredths* as: 214.36. Kids in Canada, England, Australia, Korea, Japan, India and China write it the same way.

Kids in Brazil, France, Greece, Cuba, Ecuador, Italy, Finland, and South Africa use a comma instead of a dot to separate the whole number from the decimal. They would write the same number as 214,36 which may look odd to us!
