Shirley Jackson (1916-1965) was an American author who wrote in the genres of Sci-Fi, horror, and mystery. She had an extremely prolific career that spanned two decades, having composed six novels, two memoirs, and more than 200 short stories.

Born in San Francisco, California, Jackson later attended Syracuse University in New York, where she became involved with the university's literary magazine and met her future husband. She later settled in Vermont where she worked as a writer.
