Write a 5-line poem based on a story you enjoy.

First Line = One Syllable
Second Line = Two Syllables
Third Line = Three Syllables
Fourth Line = Four Syllables
Fifth Line = One Syllable

The last line should be a synonym of the first word in the poem. Center the words so the poem is shaped like a lantern.

Example (based on "Charlotte's Web"):

Farms,
pigs,
rain drops and
yellow flowered
fields.
