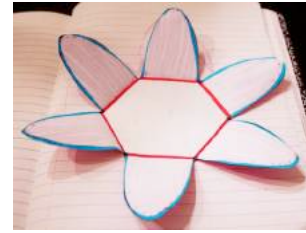


# Who Am I? Theorists Directions

8. The power-elite pull the strings in society—the rest of us are just puppets. **C. Wright Mills**



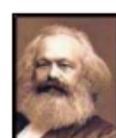
